Awareness event from the Youth Platform

The Youth Platform, formed by the Municipality of Kyrenia from young people aged 15-21, was held on Monday, July 5, at the Boğaz Picnic Area, organised an environmental cleaning awareness event with the slogan"Whose Responsibility is the Garbage?". In the event attended by young people from ÇADER (Çatalköy Development and Culture Association) and environmentally sensitive Take Action group, wastes were collected, classified and separated. The youth, who were divided into groups of four, also collected data in this study.

The Kyrenia Youth Platform brought food for street animals and donated to the Golden Paws Association. The young people who showed their sensitivity called on everyone to be sensitive to the environment and take responsibility.

The youngsters brought their second-hand books with them. The books they will collect at the events will be donated to people and institutions in need at the end of the summer.

"The responsibility belongs to all of us"

Talking about the event, Take Action member Erna Yurtdaş said, "We should not lose hope for a cleaner Cyprus, we should all act together."

Youth Platform Representative Hazay Say Ötun spoke on behalf of the Youth Platform and emphasised that the responsibility for environmental pollution belongs to all of us.

Supporting the event, Çatalköy Development and Culture Association (ÇADER) Member Irene Raab Marancos said, "It gives us hope to organise these events with young people. We did not only collect waste here, but also created awareness about the separation of garbage," she said.

"We will determine our roadmap"

Kyrenia Mayor Nidai Güngördü reminded that the environmental problem created in the Boğaz Picnic Area has been going on for years, and said, "This event is the first step of the work to be done on the recycling of waste materials. Garbage removed from the Boğaz Picnic Area will enable us to collect data for research.

As a result of the data, we will know what we will encounter and determine our roadmap accordingly. We have always said that the Boğaz Picnic Area, which is affiliated to the Forestry Department, should be placed under the control of the Kyrenia Municipality, as we had requested before, and that we want to welcome the people who come here for a picnic with a nice, clean environment. I would like to thank the Social Affairs Branch and everyone who contributed to the Kyrenia Municipality Youth Platform."

Leymosun Culture House reopened for PCR tests

PCR tests have started to be carried out again at the Leymosun Culture House belonging to the Kyrenia Municipality.

In order to reduce the current density in the PCR Center in Kyrenia, which is affiliated to the Ministry of Health, and to prevent the citizens from suffering, Kyrenia Municipality has put Leymosun Culture House, which belongs to the Municipality, back into service as a PCR Center, in cooperation

with the Ministry of Health. PCR tests are done between 08:00-14:00 on Monday-Saturday and between 08:00-13:00 on Sunday.



The municipal police officers, who work with electrical bicycles that facilitate mobility and allow more comfortable intervention in events in closed-to-traffic areas, continue their duties at full speed in Kyrenia. The importance of using these rechargeable bicycles, which work entirely with environmentally friendly technology, in order to be able to intervene more quickly in the events that occur in the traffic-free areas in the city center or in the areas where pedestrians use more frequently was mentioned.

"We must attach importance to technologies working with sustainable energy for an environmentally friendly life"

Nidai Güngördü, Mayor of Kyrenia, made a statement on the subject; "In these days when we see the effects of global warming a lot, we need to act with the awareness of protecting our environment. As the Kyrenia Municipality, we are aware that we need to give more importance to the environmentalist approach. In this context, besides our motorised teams, our electrical bicycle teams also work in the Kyrenia traffic". Pointing out that electrical bicycles are more comfortable in terms of use and environmentally friendly in terms of working with sustainable energy, Güngördü stated that they should continue this practice, which they are a pioneer in the Municipality of Northern Cyprus, and that studies are being carried out in this context.
